

Events of yesteryear:

- 1949 Bill Donohue & his crew of members  
~~repainted the hall~~
- 1953 Regus Park was dedicated to  
Arthur Regus in recognition of  
unselfish service to this community.  
Mr. Regus was an outstanding  
member of O.P.L.A., our oldest  
active member for 35 years.  
He donated the cannons at the  
entrance of Thicket Street. These  
cannons were almost lost to the  
scrap drive in 1942.
- 1953 Bill Donohue charred a black dance
- 1958 O.P.L.A. held a Chicken Barbecue
1962. A symbolic mortgage burning  
celebration took place at the hall.
- 1966 Jack Doyle & Phil Chamberlain
