

Jan 1941 Talk by Mr Ronald White on proposed airport in Wey. as a dirigible base housing 300 officers & 100 civilian employees
Improvements - worked with selectmen in 1941 - signs at intersections in So Wey. recommended that the state take over the upkeep of its 128

Feb 1941 Mr. Wm Park relinquished his ^{past} position as scoutmaster to the new scout ^{troop} master Mr Robert Park.

In 1941 our building & land was assessed for \$ 9,400.00
The hall burned wood & coal for heat.

Cannons at junction of Pond & Thicket Sts.

Nov. 1942 - The club of the Board of Selectmen requested Pond Plain to give the cannons up for the scrap drive. Arthur Regus (pres of SSPA) - and active member had given the cannon to the Park dept.

1943 122 families were members

1947 Pond Plain Athletic Club we sponsored

" 46 memberships accepted & membership drive

" influential in obtaining policemen for evening at Pond school

1948 Bill Downers joined SSPA

Oct 1949 - secret ballot was taken to sell or not sell land to pay for the new heating system which was to cost \$1300.00. Total votes 59 for - 65 against 24 - 2/3 vote - motion to sell land passed. ^{for 2,000.00}

Sept 7, 1950 - second parcel of land sold to Lemuel Brown for 625.00
